Entry Fees

Regular Classes \$20 Non-Regular Classes \$15
Junior Showmanship free if dog is entered in a regular class

Class Descriptions - Classes apply for both dogs and bitches

- Non-Regular: Best Baby Puppy 3-6 mos.
 - Non-Regular: Best Spay or Neuter

Junior Showmanship - Junior, Intermediate and Senior Classes

- Junior Class - Boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 12 years old on the day of the show.
- Intermediate Class - Boys and girls who are at least 12 years old and under 15 years old on the day of the show.
- Senior Class - Boys and girls who are at least 15 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show.

Regular Conformation Classes for both Dogs and Bitches

- **Puppy** - Six to nine months on day of show
- Nine to twelve months of age on day of show.
- Twelve to Eighteen Mos. on day of show.
- 1st Place Puppy winners compete for Best Youth Male/Female
- **Adult Classes (all over 18 mos.):**
- Novice
- Bred By Exhibitor - Dogs must exhibited by their owner-breeder
- Foreign Bred - Whelped outside the United States
- Open
- Veteran Dog/Bitch
- LCA Champion Dog -- LCA Champion Bitch. Only the first

place winner(s) of these classes will compete for Best In Specialty Show. They do not compete for Winners Dog/Bitch.

- The Best Youth Male/Female will compete with the first place adult winners for Winners Dog/Bitch.
- The Reserve Winners Dog or Bitch will be selected from among the remaining first place winners and the second place class dog or bitch to the one selected Winners Dog/Bitch.

Trophies and rosettes shall be presented for:
Best of Breed - Best of Opposite Sex - Best of Winners

Ribbons will be presented for first thru fourth class placements.

Ribbons and special awards will be given to non-regular class winners and to Junior Showmanship winners.

- GLLC does not recognize champion titles from non-LCA venue.
- Champions from other venues must enter the regular classes
- All entrants must be LCA or FSS registered.
- All dogs must be on leash or crated at all times. The club reserves the right to excuse any dog from the show that is out of control or exhibits aggression to any dog or person.
